	<i>Headquarters for Asahi Breweries, meant to resemble a pint. Black building adjacent is Asahi Beer Hall and the curious golden squiggle is the Asahi Flame. In the Asahi Annex building you can find Tokyo Sumidagawa Brewing, a subsidiary of Asahi Brewing (craft). Taster set available. You can get dinner here, although try reserving a table to ensure you get in.</i>
